SUBJECT: AUDIO-VISUAL LEARNING SUPPORT - 24/7 ON DEMAND



Dear Colleagues,

The Ministry of Education, Youth and Information (MoEYI) continues to provide support for curriculum delivery through audio-visual lessons. These lessons can be utilized by teachers, students and parents to facilitate teaching and learning during these challenging times. The MoEYI is using every available modality and distribution platform that can cover as wide a population as possible to ensure equitable access to quality education.

For the academic year 2021/2022, audio-visual content will be aired using the Ministry owned **eHomeSchool Network Primary and Secondary Channels, Public Broadcasting Corporation of Jamaica (PBCJ) Television** and **MoEYI's YouTube Channels**. Please see the appended **television schedules for the month of September 2021** for your attention and information.

TV channels:

The MoEYI's **eHomeSchool Network** now has two (2) dedicated channels:

eHomeSchool-PRIMARY  and **eHomeSchool-SECONDARY**  with live and recorded classes, news and information available 24-hours per day, 7-days per week. These channels are currently available via:

1. **Over the Air:** Both channels are available on digital TV using a digital flat screen television and a UHF antenna. This means that households without cable will have access to televised learning enabled by the use of their “rabbit ear” antenna.
2. **PBCJ** - The Ministry continues to partner with PBCJ to air quality audio visual content that will focus on the early childhood to the secondary levels as per the attached schedule.
3. **Cable:** 25 cable networks including the island-wide providers, **FLOW - channel 140, Digicel - channel 6** and **Ready TV - channel - 102.**

eHomeSchool - SECONDARY has also been offered to the cable operators for carriage. For ease of access, parents and students may call their cable operator for the channel number on their community cable service. If the cable operator does not currently offer the eHomeSchool channels, please advise the operator to call **876-321-1805** and the channels will be distributed to them.

Grade Level Materials

Grades 1-3

All primary schools are being provided with the following:

The above titles are workbooks and so the students should be allowed to write in them. These workbooks are consumables and will be replaced annually.

Grades 4-6

The core titles at the Grades 4-6 levels which were provisioned at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year are **not to be written in** as they are to be used for at least **three** years before any replacement can be considered.
